



## Construction activities performed during the Week of 10/08/2017 – 10/14/2017 are listed below:

- Sterling continued excavating and preparing subgrade for detour construction in Phase 1 on west side of FM 1626.
- Sterling continued stripping and hauling off topsoil from Oyster Creek Dr. to Onion Creek.
- Sterling continued placing driveway drainage culverts south of Coldwater Hollow.
- Sterling poured the bottom slab at Culvert 4 upstream. (100% complete)
- Subcontractor DC Civil continued the portion of Waterline A construction along the east ROW south of Oyster Creek Dr. (60% Complete Overall)
- Frontier was onsite wrecking old utility lines from Mustang Creek to RM 967.
- Spectrum was not on site removing old utility lines this week.

## Anticipated activities for the next week are as follows:

- Sterling to continue earthwork activities for Phase 1 detours.
- Sterling to continue placing driveway drainage culverts south of Oyster Creek Dr.
- Sterling to begin constructing columns at Mustang Creek bridge.
- Sterling to begin preparing for drilled shaft operations at Onion Creek bridge.
- Subcontractor Austin Materials to begin pavement repairs throughout the project.
- Subcontractor DC Civil to continue Waterline A construction from Oyster Creek to north of Coldwater Hollow.
- Spectrum to continue removing old utility lines throughout the project.
- Frontier to continue removing the old utility lines throughout the project.
